Work on indigenous, minority, and under-researched languages is particularly encouraged.

The conference supports a multi- and inter-disciplinary approach across phonology, phonetics, interfaces with other grammatical levels, speech production, speech perception, psycholinguistics, clinical linguistics, sign language phonology, computational modelling, educational approaches, and the application of new technologies.

Theoretical, experimental, and clinical contributions are welcome.

Doctoral students, speech language pathologists, and representatives of minority groups are also especially encouraged.

Provide 4-7 keywords. Doulos SIL is to be used for phonetic symbols.
